ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE (Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within the community.)

The Wing-Crocker House is a full five bay Cape cottage enclosed by a gable roof. Its center entry is framed by pilasters and headed by a rectangular transom with unusual radiating muntins. Windows are simply framed and contain 6/6 sash. The house is sheathed in shingles.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE (Explain the role owners played in local or state history and how the building relates to the development of the community.)

When Calvin Crocker purchased this property from John and Abigail Wing in 1800 it gave him ownership of property in the area where Deacon William Crocker owned 100 acres when he died in 1692. The property is near the town boundary line of Barnstable and Sandwich and the Wing family is prominent in the history of the Town of Sandwich. The deed does not clearly state that a dwelling house was on the property when purchased in 1800. The house has a sign on it which says "built in 1750". It is located on the north side of Race Lane.
